2021-2022 REGISTRATION & INFORMATION

Children enrolled in the Nearly Two program must be turning two between January 1, 2022 and March, 2022.

Registration dates are listed below. Your application will not be processed until the proper date.

1. Families of returning students have priority until January 5th
2. Church member applications are processed beginning January 6th
3. Alumni family applications are processed beginning January 13th
4. Open enrollment begins January 20th

You need to send a \$50 non-refundable registration fee made out to **Huguenot Memorial Church** with this application; your child's application will not be accepted without this fee. If your child attends Huguenot Nursery School the \$50 will be credited towards your June tuition payment.

Contracts will be mailed the first week of February and are due back with a \$300 non-refundable tuition deposit by February 12th in order to guarantee a spot.

FEE SCHEDULE:

1. \$50 non-refundable deposit due with the application.
2. \$300.00 non-refundable deposit due with signed contract by February 12th.
3. One-third, minus the \$350 deposit, due June 1; one-third due September 1; final one-third payment due December 1.

REFUND POLICY:

If you withdraw prior to July 1st you receive 100% of the June payment.
If you withdraw on or after July 1st you receive 50% of the June payment.
If you withdraw on or after August 1st there is no refund.

*Withdrawals must be in writing and be postmarked by the due date
