

## HUGUENOT NURSERY SCHOOL- BRIDGE PROGRAM

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### 2021-2022 REGISTRATION & INFORMATION

Registration dates are listed below. Your application will not be processed until the proper date.

1. Families of returning students have priority until January 5<sup>th</sup>
2. Families that were enrolled for school year 2020 – 2021 but did not attend due to COVID applications are processed beginning January 6<sup>th</sup>.
3. Church member applications are processed beginning January 11<sup>th</sup>
4. Alumni family applications are processed beginning January 14<sup>th</sup>
5. Open enrollment begins January 20<sup>th</sup>

You need to send a \$50 non-refundable registration fee made out to **Huguenot Memorial Church** with this application; your child's application will not be accepted without this fee. If your child attends Huguenot Nursery School the \$50 will be credited towards your June tuition payment.

Contracts will be mailed the first week of February and are due back with a \$300 non-refundable tuition deposit by February 12<sup>th</sup> in order to guarantee a spot.

**FEE SCHEDULE:** Tuition: \$16,500

1. \$50 non-refundable deposit due with the application.
2. \$300.00 non-refundable deposit due with signed contract by February 12<sup>th</sup>.
3. One-third, minus the \$350 deposit, due June 1; one-third due September 1; final one-third payment due December 1.

### **REFUND POLICY:**

If you withdraw prior to July 1<sup>st</sup> you receive 100% of the June payment.

If you withdraw on or after July 1<sup>st</sup> you receive 50% of the June payment.

If you withdraw on or after August 1<sup>st</sup> there is no refund.

\*Withdrawals must be in writing and be postmarked prior to the due date.





### Bridge Program

This class is for children who will be 5 no later than December 31<sup>st</sup> 2021 and whose parents feel their child would benefit from another year in a small class setting.

The class will follow the Common Core to develop reading and math skills. The teacher will be in frequent contact with Pelham Public School staff to ensure that we are following the kindergarten curriculum. There will be lots of time for free play, creative art, music and outdoor time.

The curriculum will include:

1. Language Arts and Writing
2. Phonics
3. Math
4. Science
5. Creative Arts
